

RULES OF POKER RUN

You must be pre-register before July 14 2018. The ride is not a race and will be approximately 280KM. You will have 5 stops.

Riders must pickup their scorecards for the Poker Run at the Rendezvous registration table between 8:00 – 8:50 am on July 20th 2018.

Riders / co-riders may draw 1 card from each stop until they total five cards

First card will be picked at the registration table with your scorecard.

You will have 3 other locations to pick up card and the last card will be picked up at the registration table when returning your scorecard. Players will not be permitted to pick up all cards at one stop.

No duplicate cards can be used. Participants must draw an additional card if an identical card is drawn.

If playing MORE than one hand (multiple scorecards), the participant must present the appropriate Scorecard to be marked **BEFORE** each card is drawn.

You must present each scorecard, then pick one card at a time, and lay it face up on the table

First Card pull is free. If participant is unhappy with card pull they may return the card and purchase another draw for \$2 dollar. Participant can purchase up to 3 different card pulls at one stop. Participant must stick with card **they pull last**.

******Cannot choose best out of 4 card pulls******

Once participant has their last pull or are satisfied with initial card pull one of the volunteers must initial poker run card in the spot that identifies which card the person pulled.

****On stop 2 through 5, if a participant should pull a card that is already showing on their poker run card they must pull another card (at no charge) – so if I am at stop 3 and I pull a 10 of Hearts as my card and that was my card at stop 1 (initialed on my poker run card) I get to pull another card. ****

Riders must complete the run and be at the hotel no later than 3:00 pm and present their score card to the judges at the registration table. The scorecard skill-testing question must be answered. The best hand and the lowest hand will win a cash prize.

In case of a tie, there will be a draw for High Card to determine the winner

All decisions of the judges are FINAL! Participants must be present (___pm-___pm) to claim their prize(s). Make certain you send it back to me with the information you request DO NOT email this out yet
